Today you are a Freelance Photographer

Here is your assignment:

1. Shoot images for the front covers of **TWO** fictitious magazines from Table 1 (below).

(This part of the assignment is COMPULSORY)

The magazines are A4 portrait format (i.e. your images will be 1050 pixels max high). Don't forget to allow space for the magazine title and a few words about content.

Images for the cover of the “**Black & White Photography**” magazine are always in black & white. If you present images for this title you will gain an extra **TWO** points.

2. Shoot images for inclusion in each of **FOUR** of the remaining fictitious magazines.

The images may be either portrait or landscape (i.e. 1050 pixels max high or 1400 pixels max wide).

3. Shoot **THREE** images for a Harwich & Dovercourt Tourist Information leaflet.

The images may be either portrait or landscape but must promote the towns at their best. If you wish, you may combine images using Photoshop or other image manipulation programmes.

You are provided with overview and detailed maps of the suggested route. However, you do not have to visit ALL of the stops to complete your assignment.

The competition is open to ALL participants (members and non-members) who may also attend, gratis, on the evening of the competition. An entry form is attached.
