### RULES

#### Meetings

All Members are entitled to attend any Society meeting. All Members are entitled to attend any Group meeting. Attendance at Group meetings may be limited and is by arrangement with the Group Leader. Meetings are published in the Society's Programme Booklet.

#### Competitions

There will be a series of monthly competitions for Prints and Projected Images. The Committee makes the rules for the competitions. Associate members are not eligible to enter work in Monthly Competitions.

#### Groups

At members' request the Society's Committee may form special interest Groups and may appoint a Group Leader to co-ordinate each Group's activities. A Group Leader shall be an ex-officio member of the Society's Committee. Group Leaders will advise the Society's Committee of the Groups' activities.

Each Group Leader will account to the Treasurer of the Society for any income or expenditure of the Group.

#### Exhibition

There will be an Annual Exhibition of members' work organised by the Print and Projected Image Exhibition Secretaries. The Society's Committee appoints the Exhibition Secretaries and makes the rules for the Exhibition. Trophies and Awards may be awarded to encourage participation and recognise work of merit. Associate Members are not eligible to enter work for the Annual Exhibition. The Society's Committee may organise other displays of members' work from time to time.

#### Bulletin

The Bulletin will be published three times a year to inform members of news, views, activities and articles of interest. The Bulletin Editor is appointed by the Society's Committee and is responsible for the editorial content, preparation and publishing of the Bulletin. Editorial policy is set by the Society's Committee.

#### Website

The Society will maintain a Website to provide information to members and non members and to display portfolios of members work. The Web Master is appointed by the Society's Committee and is responsible for the editorial content, preparation and publishing of the Website. Editorial policy is set by the Society's Committee.

#### Subscriptions

Subscriptions are payable annually and become due on 1<sup>st</sup> September. The membership of any member who has not paid their annual subscription by 15<sup>th</sup> October will lapse.

The Society's Committee reviews and sets the Subscriptions annually.

From the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 subscriptions are:

Ordinary Members	£45

#### Concessions

**Country Concession** – applies to Ordinary Members who live further than 25 miles from the Society's headquarters calculated by the shortest road distance.

***New Members' Concession*** – those joining the Society between 1<sup>st</sup> March and the end of August of the current season will be granted membership until the beginning of the next following season ie one year and up to six months of membership.
