Title for the Set of Three				

- **Beginners'** entries must be indicated with a "B" in the column "Ref" (Rule 31).
- Entries for the Set of Three Section must be marked in boxes 15, 16 and 17.
- Digital images to have the author name, title and B for entries to the Beginners' section embedded in the Exif data.
- Set of Three is judged separately and is Open. There is no Set of Three in the Beginners Section .
- **Entry Fees are £15.00 per category – therefore if you enter prints and Projected Images the fee is £25.**

Summary of Entry Rules- Projected Images



Entrants should read the Exhibition Rules in full – these may be found at: www.idps.org.uk on the [Exhibition](#) page.

All members of the Society except Associates may submit entries.

Members may enter up to 20 monochrome or colour prints and 15 projected images.

Images (or similar versions of images) which have been exhibited in previous IDPS Annual Exhibitions or had two previous rejections cannot be entered. An image may only be entered once i.e. as a print or a projected image (DPI) in any year.

Entries must be submitted by the entry deadline to the Exhibition Secretary together with a fully completed entry form and the correct entry fee.

The Society takes no responsibility for loss of, or damage to, entries.

Entry Categories

Beginners' entries are judged separately see Rule 29 for the definition of Beginner.

Beginner's entries must be marked with a "B" on the entry form.

Copyright

The copyright of all elements of the images must be at the disposal of the entrant – no clip art or royalty free images may be used. Copyright remains with the entrant but IDPS may reproduce any image for publicity purposes and/or place it on the website unless the entrant expressly states otherwise on the entry form.

Digital Images for Projection (DPI's)

Digital Images must be submitted on DVD, CD or USB memory stick – these must be clearly labelled with the entrant's name, alternatively they may be emailed to the Exhibition Secretary.

Images must be saved to the media in a single folder (named as the entrants name e.g. Joe Bloggs).

Images must be maximum of 1600 pixels wide and 1200 pixels high and saved as jpg (JPEG) at maximum (12) quality.

The Colour Space must be sRGB.

Each image must have the title and author entered in the EXIF data. Beginners entries must have B entered in the subject/description in the Exif data. See "How to Prepare Images for DPI Competitions and the Exhibition" on the [Exhibition](#) page of www.idps.org.uk

Filenaming – all digital image files to be named NN_title_members name where NN is the entry number on the entry form, e.g. 01_Red Kite_Matt Clarke.
