

### **General Rules for all Cup and Trophy Competitions**

Entry is open to all members of the Society, except associates, but members are limited to one entry for each competition (except the George Farthing which allows two entries). Subject matter is unrestricted (except the George Farthing Trophy which is for landscape).

The award-winning panel/set for each competition will be exhibited at the Society's next annual exhibition.

All prints and projected images entered are eligible for entry in the Annual Exhibition if they also conform to the conditions of entry of the Exhibition.

Prints or DPs previously entered in these competitions, or accepted in IDPS Annual Exhibitions, are not eligible and must not be included in entries.

Entries must originate from photographic images taken by the author. If graphics are introduced they should be kept to a minimum. Clip art and royalty free images are not allowed.

### **George Farthing Trophy**

This trophy is awarded annually to the winner of a competition for the **best Landscape or Seascape** image.

How to Enter:

1. TWO digital images may be entered per entrant.
2. Images should not be more than two years old.
- 3. Image title and photographer's name must be included in the EXIF data**
4. Images should be supplied in JPEG format and emailed to [dpicompsec@idps.org.uk](mailto:dpicompsec@idps.org.uk) with "George Farthing Entry" in the subject line
5. Images should be sized to fit within 1600 x 1200 pixels.
6. File names should be in the format Entrant's Name\_Title e.g Joe Bloggs \_Dales Landscape.
7. All constituent parts of a digitally manipulated image must be the sole work of the entrant.

### **Steeds Cup**

This Cup is awarded annually a set for eight (8) projected images which exhibit **the best all-round photographic ability**.

How to Enter:

1. Digital images must be named i01.jpg, i02.jpg etc. where the number represents the order in which the set should be projected
2. Images should be saved as maximum quality jpeg at a resolution of 1600 by 1200 pixels.
- 3. Image title and photographer's name must be included in the EXIF data**
4. Images must be less than two years old at the date of entry
5. Entries should be emailed to [dpicompsec@idps.org.uk](mailto:dpicompsec@idps.org.uk) with "Steeds Cup Entry" in the subject line.

### **Nacton Cup**

This trophy is awarded annually for an entry of **five (5) related projected images that form a set**.

How to enter:

1. Images must be named i01.jpg, i02.jpg etc. where the number represents the projection order of the set.
2. Images should be saved as maximum quality jpeg at a resolution of 1600 by 1200 pixels.
- 3. Image title and photographer's name must be included in the EXIF data**
4. Entries should be emailed to [dpicompsec@idps.org.uk](mailto:dpicompsec@idps.org.uk) with "Nacton Cup Entry" in the subject line
