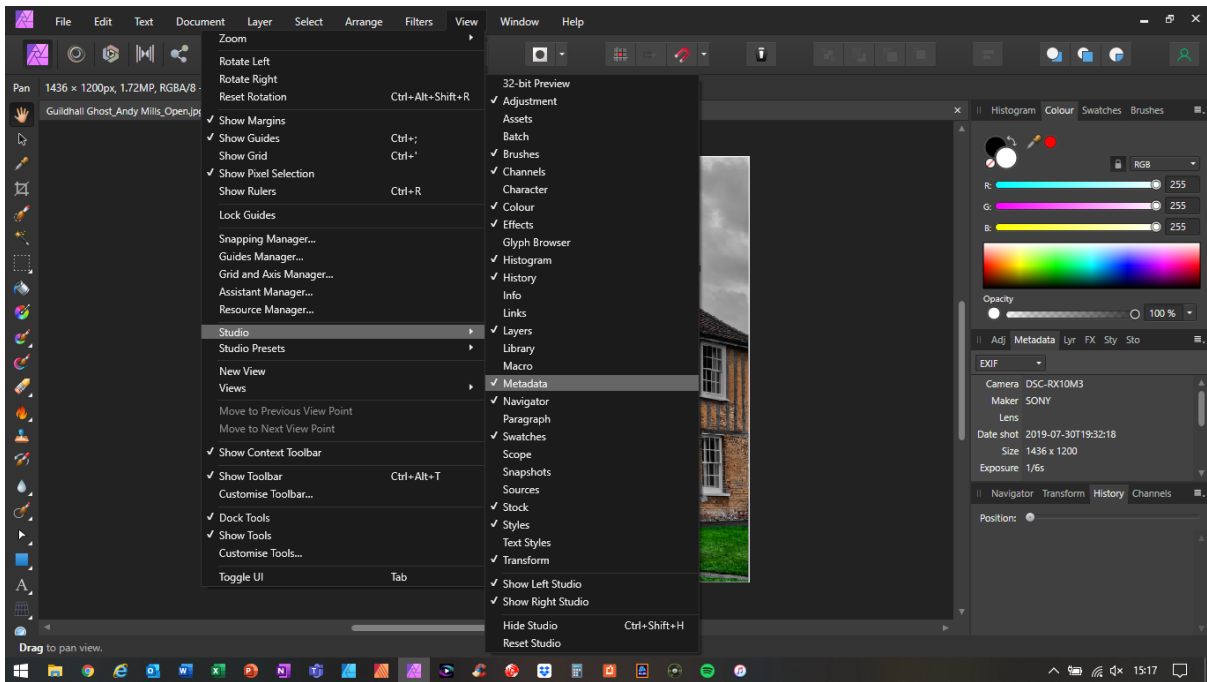


How to Edit Metadata in Affinity Photo

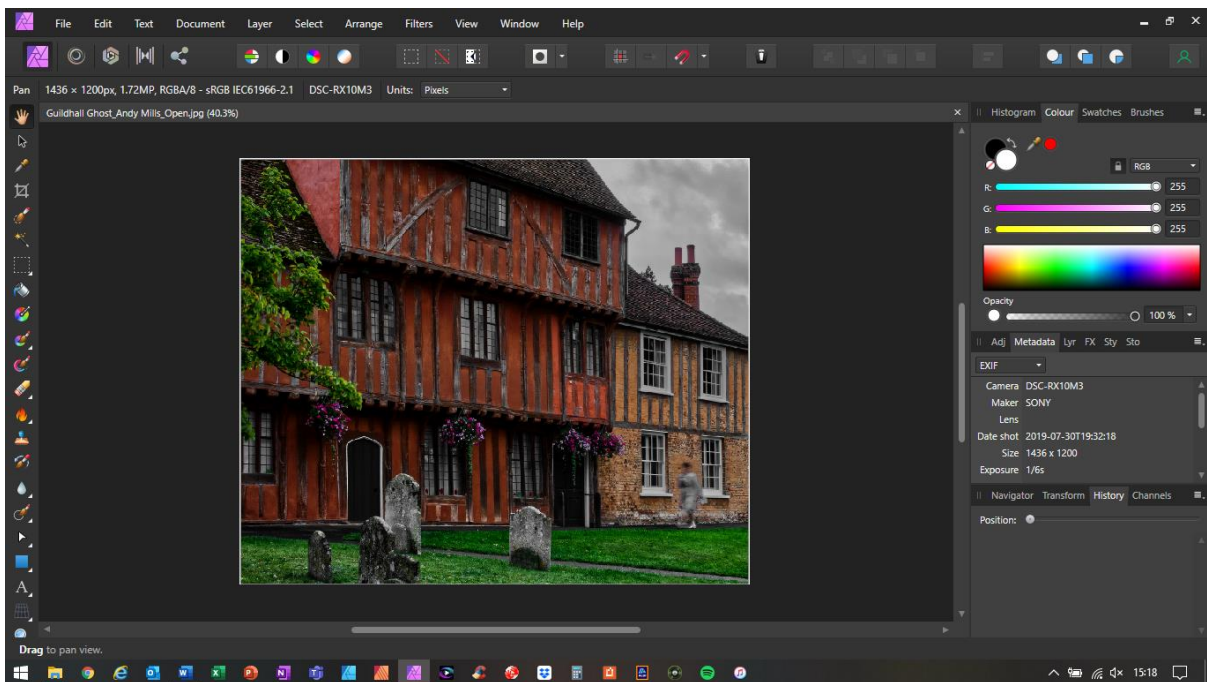
The IDPS requires information to be entered into the metadata about each image submitted for a competition. This paper outlines how to do that in Affinity Photo.

Open the image in Affinity Photo.

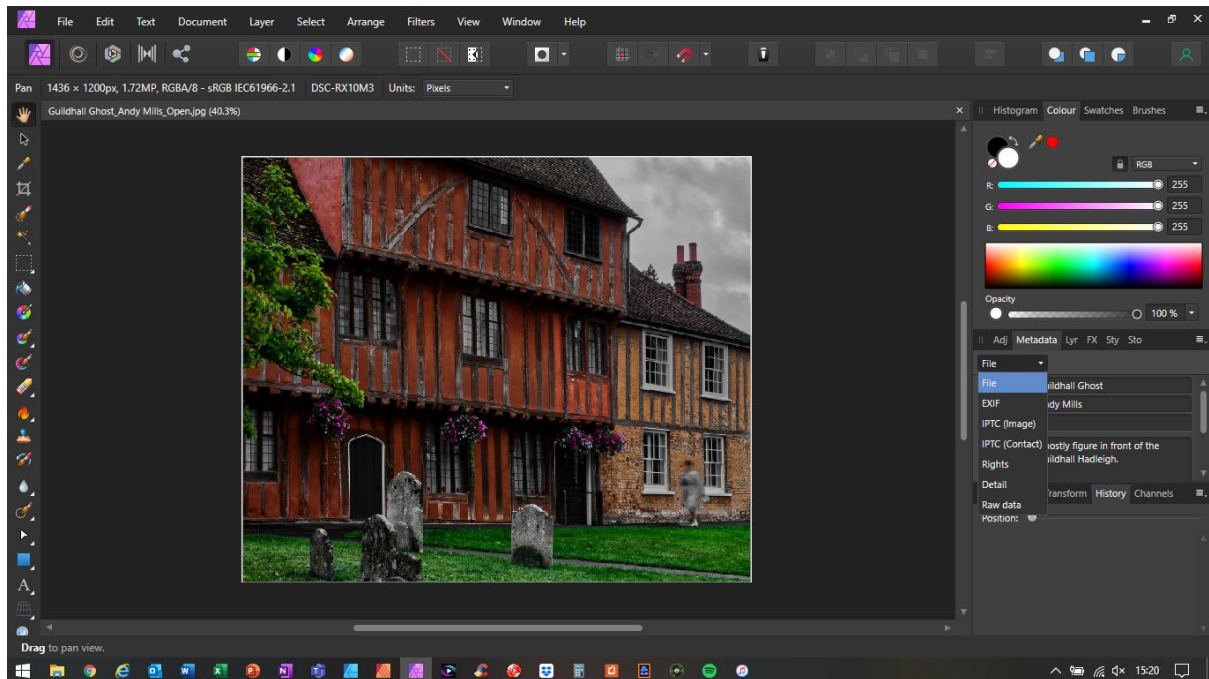
Click on the View drop-down menu to ensure Metadata is visible in the Studio – it needs to be ticked:



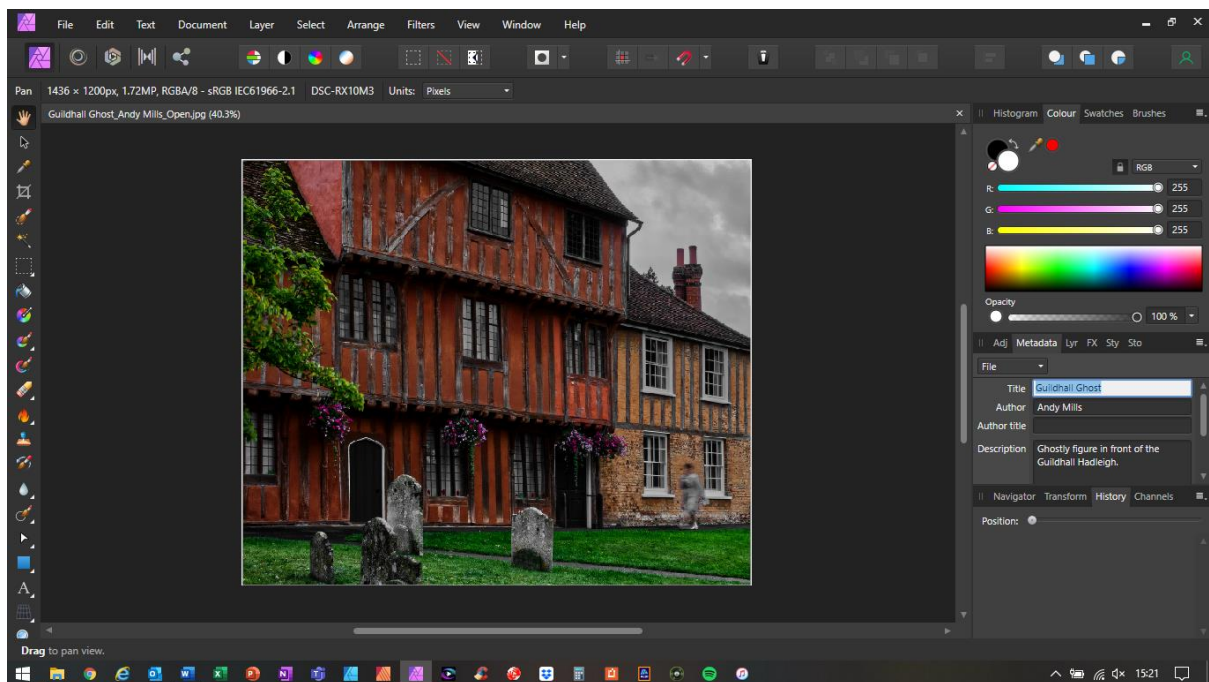
You should then be able to see Mtd or Metadata in the panel on the right:



By default it shows EXIF data but the little dropdown menu (where it says EXIF) allows you to change that to File:



You can then type the required details about the image as File data:



IDPS requires the image title, author and a brief description to be entered.

When you save or export the image the Metadata is saved with the image in the JPG file.
