- A. For each competition an entrant **MUST** complete an entry form and supply it with their prints. **Fill in the competition date, your name and the titles of your prints. Also indicate your classification by crossing out that which is NOT applicable.** A completed sample is shown below.

B. PLEASE WRITE YOUR NAME AND PRINT TITLE CLEARLY ON THE BACK OF THE MOUNT, AT THE TOP LEFT CORNER

A print label has been designed to simplify the procedure for both the entrant and the organiser. **THIS LABEL IS TO BE AFFIXED ON THE BACK OF THE MOUNT NEAR THE MIDDLE TOP** – please avoid sticking the label on the mounting tape.

These images will be used on the IDPS website and for archiving to assist selection for external competition.
